



Insurance Requirements

In certain situations with high value equipment we require you to maintain third-party insurance coverage against loss or damage to our equipment.

Usually we require this insurance when the equipment you are renting has a replacement cost exceeding \$10,000.

The insurance is a measure of security that we will be repaid should an unexpected loss or theft occur while the equipment is out on rental.

If you do not have Production insurance, short-term policies start around \$200 for \$20,000 in equipment coverage. We suggest [Athos Insurance](#) for Insurance. You can get production insurance usually within minutes of paying online.

Insurance Requirements

- ✓ Hawaii Camera must be listed as a Loss Payee at 3457 Waiialae Ave, Unit 203, Honolulu, HI 96816 on the Certificate of Insurance.
- ✓ The named insured on the policy must be the same person or entity listed on the Rental agreement.
- ✓ The policy must cover Rented Equipment.
- ✓ The policy must not contain exclusions for Unattended or Unlocked Vehicles.
- ✓ The policy should expire no less than 7 days after your expected return date.
- ✓ The policy should have a coverage amount equal to or greater than the replacement value of the equipment you are rented.
- ✓ Deductibles greater than \$500 may need to be paid as a credit card deposit.
